

## Easy Linen Eyelet Spa Mitt by Diane Malinowski



Pattern for a spa mitt which can be made out of DK or sport weight linen yarn.

**Finished measurements approx:** 20cm long (8") 13cm wide (5") washed and blocked.

**Gauge in DK yarn:** 20 stitches and 30 rows = 4 inches/10cm in garter stitch.

**Needles:** 3.75/4mm (US 5/6) + 4mm crochet hook for chain (optional)

**Yarn:** **eco-stitch DK linen solids:** one 50g ball (one mitt) or

**Flaxi:** one 50g skein or

**Hand-dyed 100% linen Sport:** one 100g skein which will make 2 mitts

**Abbreviations/stitches:** k = knit    st = stitch    k2tog = knit 2 together    YO = yarn over

### Pattern instructions.

Cast on 29 sts.

k 1 row

\*k 11 rows.

Eyelet row: [k2tog , YO] repeat until last st, k last st\* Repeat between \* and \* 4 more times

k 21 rows

Eyelet row: [k2tog , YO] repeat until last st, k last st.

\*\*k 11 rows.

Eyelet row: [k2tog , YO] repeat until last st, k last st\*\* Repeat between \*\* 4 more times

k 12 rows.

Cast off and make optional loop: Leave last st on needle. Break yarn leaving enough length to form a chain loop (30cm approx). Transfer last stitch on to crochet hook and chain 14 st. Tie off end and with a darning needle attach end of chain to corner of cloth.

Fold piece in half and seam sides. Weave in loose ends. Hand-wash and dry flat.
