

Linen Spa Back Scrubber by Diane Malinowski



This is a pattern for a linen back scrubber which is hand-knitted with DK or sport weight linen yarn.

Finished measurements approx: 88cm long (34") 13cm wide (5") washed and blocked.

Gauge: 22 stitches and 3 rows = 4 inches/10cm in garter stitch after washing/blocking.

Needles: 3.75 (US 5) + 3.5mm crochet hook for reinforcing the thumb hole.

Yarn: **eco-stitch sport hand-dyed 100% linen** 1 x 100g skein from www.eco-stitch.co.uk shown in the Sunset colourway.

Abbreviations/stitches: k = knit st = stitch k2tog = knit 2 together YO = yarn over

Pattern instructions.

Cast on 31 sts.

k 12 rows

k11 sts, cast off next 9 stitches, k11 sts

k11 sts, cast on 9 stitches, k11 sts

k 10 rows

**Eyelet row: [k2tog , YO] repeat until last st, k last st

k 11 rows**

Repeat between ** 15 more times

k11 sts, cast off next 9 stitches, k11 sts

k11 sts, cast on 9 stitches, k11 sts

k 12 rows and cast off.

Reinforce the thumb hole at each end by doing one round of single crochet.

Weave in ends.
